Integrated Wellness Camp: Counselling, Physiotherapy & Mental Health for Female Students

II. Introduction

The Department of Biotechnology, Rajarshi Shahu Mahavidyalaya, Latur (Autonomous), successfully organized an Integrated Wellness Camp focused on counselling, physiotherapy, and mental health awareness for female students on 10^{th} September 2025. The camp was conducted with the aim of promoting holistic health and well-being among young women, emphasizing the importance of mental, emotional and physical wellness in academic and personal life. Renowned medical professionals including Dr. Atul Venkatesh Kulkarni, Dr. Rajesaheb Chavan, Dr. Rekha Zipre, Dr. Kiran Chavan and Mr. Suraj Gaikwad were invited as resource persons for this initiative. These experts provided one-on-one counselling sessions, addressing a range of psychological and emotional concerns faced by students. The camp also included physiotherapy consultations to assist students with posture, pain management and stress-related physical conditions. Furthermore, homeopathic medicines were provided as part of a preventive and supportive healthcare approach.

III. Objectives of the Programme/ Issues addressed

- To promote awareness about mental health and emotional well-being among female students through expert-led counselling sessions.
- > To provide professional physiotherapy consultations aimed at addressing physical health issues related to posture, stress, and sedentary academic routines.
- ➤ To offer personalized homeopathic support and guidance as a preventive approach to common physical and psychological concerns.
- ➤ To create a safe and supportive environment where female students feel comfortable discussing personal health challenges with qualified medical professionals.
- ➤ To empower students with practical strategies and resources for maintaining holistic health, thereby enhancing their academic performance and overall quality of life.

IV. Details of Participants

v. Brief Summary of Events/Sessions

The Integrated Wellness Camp aimed to foster holistic well-being by addressing the mental,

emotional, and physical health challenges commonly faced by young women in academic settings.

The camp was conducted by a team of expert medical professionals, including Dr. Atul Venkatesh

Kulkarni, Dr. Rajesaheb Chavan, Dr. Rekha Zirpe, Dr. Kiran Chavan, and Mr. Suraj Gaikwad,

accompanied by a team of 25 interns. The program began with basic health screening procedures,

where students' blood pressure and weight were measured to evaluate their general health status.

Following the screening, participants received individual counselling sessions that focused on

addressing common mental health concerns such as stress, anxiety, academic pressure, and

emotional well-being. The medical team offered professional advice and emotional support in a

confidential and empathetic setting. In addition, homeopathic medicines were distributed to

students as part of a natural and preventive healthcare approach, aiming to support both physical

and psychological balance.

VI. Conclusion with Feedback on the Programme

On the whole, the camp created a comprehensive wellness platform within the academic

environment. The enthusiastic participation of students and the positive feedback received

highlight the growing need for such holistic healthcare initiatives in educational institutions. This

camp not only helped raise awareness but also empowered students with knowledge and

resources to take better care of their overall well-being. Such efforts contribute significantly to

building a healthy, resilient, and emotionally balanced student community, and the Department of

Biotechnology remains committed to organizing more such impactful programs in the future.
