B) A Report:

i. Title: Tuberculosis Control Awareness Programme

ii. Introduction:

The Tuberculosis (TB) Control Awareness Programme was organized for NCC Cadets (SD/SW) with the objective of educating young cadets about tuberculosis prevention, early diagnosis, and available government health facilities. As future leaders and socially responsible youth, NCC cadets play a crucial role in spreading awareness and promoting healthy practices in their communities. This programme aimed to enhance their understanding of TB, remove misconceptions, and empower them to act as health ambassadors in the fight against tuberculosis.

iii. Objectives of the Programme/ issues addressed

- To create awareness among NCC Cadets (SD/SW) about Tuberculosis (TB), its causes, symptoms, and modes of transmission.
- To educate cadets on the importance of early diagnosis, sputum testing, and timely treatment under the National Tuberculosis Elimination Programme (NTEP).
- To address common misconceptions and stigma associated with TB and promote a positive and supportive attitude toward affected individuals.
- To inform cadets about government facilities such as free TB testing, DOTS treatment, and nutritional support schemes.
- To encourage cadets to act as health ambassadors and spread TB awareness in their communities.
- To highlight the role of youth in supporting India's goal of TB elimination and strengthening public health initiatives.

iv. Details of Participants:

For this event, **two ANOs** and a total of **62 NCC cadets (33 SD + 29 SW)** were present and actively participated in the awareness programme.

v. Brief Summary of Events/ Sessions:

The session began with an introduction of the resource persons, followed by an informative presentation on various aspects of Tuberculosis control and prevention. Dr. Samyank Khaire explained the causes, symptoms, and transmission of TB, emphasizing the importance of early diagnosis, sputum testing, and strict adherence to treatment. He highlighted the role of the National Tuberculosis Elimination Programme (NTEP) and the need to remove stigma associated with the disease.

Shri P. G. Golmallu further elaborated on the DOTS treatment strategy, Public-Private Mix (PPM) initiatives, and government support schemes like Nikshay Poshan Yojana. He shared practical examples to help cadets understand the seriousness of TB and the importance of community participation in controlling it.

The session was interactive, with cadets asking questions related to prevention, nutrition, and their role in spreading awareness. The experts appreciated the enthusiasm of the cadets and encouraged them to actively contribute to TB awareness drives.

vi. Conclusion, with Feedback on the Programme:

The Tuberculosis Control Awareness Programme was successful in enhancing the knowledge and social responsibility of NCC cadets. The contributions of Dr. Samyank Khaire, Shri P. G. Golmallu, Lt.
