### **i. Title: Rally on the Occasion of World Tuberculosis Day**

#### **ii. Introduction:**

World Tuberculosis (TB) Day is observed every year on 24th March to raise public awareness about the devastating health, social, and economic impact of tuberculosis and to step up efforts to end the global TB epidemic. On this occasion, a TB Awareness Rally was organized by NCC cadets to educate the community about preventive measures, early diagnosis, and the importance of completing the TB treatment. The rally aimed to highlight the message that TB is preventable and curable if timely action is taken.

#### **iii. Objectives of Rally:**
