## **B) A Report**

### **i. Title: ANO Conclave and Visit of Group Commander**

#### **ii. Introduction:**

The ANO Conclave and Visit of the Group Commander were organized to strengthen coordination between the NCC Unit, Associate NCC Officers (ANOs), and higher NCC authorities. The programme focused on reviewing ongoing NCC activities, planning future training, and motivating cadets towards better performance. It also provided a platform for ANOs to share their experiences and challenges, enabling constructive dialogue and strategic guidance from the Group Commander to enhance the overall quality of NCC training.

#### **iii. Objectives of the Programme/ issues addressed:**

- To review the functioning and training activities of the NCC Sub-Units.
- To provide a formal interaction between the Group Commander and the ANOs.
- To address administrative, training, and logistical issues faced by units.
- To plan upcoming activities including NCC Day celebrations, camps, and social awareness programs.
- To motivate ANOs and cadets for increased participation and excellence in NCC.
- To strengthen coordination among institutions under the same Group Headquarters.
- To provide guidance on SSB preparation and defense career opportunities.

#### **iv. Details of Participants:**

A total of 40 ANOs and 60 cadets (33 SD and 27 SW) actively participated in the event, making the programme highly engaging and impactful.

#### **v. Brief Summary of Events/ Sessions:**

The program began with a warm and dignified reception organized for **Brigadier Anup Barbare. Principal Dr. Mahadev Gavhane and Offg Commanding Officer Col. Y B Singh** formally received the Brigadier upon his arrival, marking the commencement of the event. This was followed by an impressive Guard of Honor presented by NCC cadets, showcasing discipline, coordination, and ceremonial precision. After the reception, the Principal and Associate NCC Officer delivered the welcome address, introducing the purpose of the ANO Conclave and emphasizing the importance of the Group Commander's visit.

Lt. Dr. Mahesh Wavare introduced the programme, after which the conclave proceeded with a comprehensive review of the functioning of the NCC sub-units. Key aspects such as parade training, attendance, documentation, uniform distribution, and overall cadet discipline were discussed. Administrative and logistic issues were addressed, along with planning for upcoming activities including annual training camps, firing practice, trekking expeditions, NCC Day celebrations, awareness rallies, and community development programmes.

The Group Commander addressed all ANOs and cadets, emphasizing leadership, discipline, punctuality, and committed training. Cadets asked questions related to SSB procedures—including psychological tests, group tasks, screening techniques, and improving Officer-Like Qualities (OLQs). He explained how regular NCC participation naturally builds leadership, teamwork, discipline, and decision-making abilities essential for defense selection.

Through this interaction, cadets received meaningful insights into defense career opportunities and personality development. The open discussion encouraged cadets to express their doubts freely and gain personalized guidance, significantly motivating them and strengthening their aspiration to join the Armed Forces while reinforcing the core values of NCC.
