#### i. Title: Thalassemia Awareness Rally

#### ii. Introduction:

On Marathwada Mukti Din, a Thalassemia Awareness Rally was organized to spread public awareness about Thalassemia—a hereditary blood disorder that requires timely diagnosis and preventive healthcare measures. The rally was conducted under the guidance of Bhalchandra Blood Bank, Latur and NCC units of Rajarshi Shahu Mahavidyalaya, Latur (Autonomous). NCC cadets actively participated with great enthusiasm, raising awareness among citizens through slogans and disciplined movement throughout the route.

#### iii. Objectives of the Rally/ issues addressed:

- To create awareness about Thalassemia, its causes, symptoms, and preventive measures.
- To educate the public on the importance of early screening, blood tests, and genetic counseling.
- To encourage the community to support voluntary blood donation, essential for Thalassemia patients.

#### iv. Details of Participants:
