





# Rules & Guidelines – GenZ Innovators Carnival Competition

## Model Presentation Rules

### Eligibility

- Open to all UG and PG students from all Fields.
- Each team must consist of minimum 2 and maximum 3 members
- Only one model/application per team is permitted

### Model Specifications

- The model/application should be compact, portable, and safe
- Teams must bring all required materials, including:
  - Model (if hardware-based)
  - Laptop / mobile device (if software or application-based)
- Internet usage will be allowed or restricted as per instructions

### Model Theme

- The model must be based on the given theme or domain
- Models may be:
  -  Hardware-based
  -  Software / Application-based (Web or Mobile)
  -  Conceptual models
- All models/applications must be original

### Presentation Rules

-  6–8 minutes for presentation
-  2–3 minutes for question & answer session
- Presentation must include:
  - Problem Statement
  - Objective
  - Working Principle / System Architecture
  - Applications
  - Future Scope

# Rules & Guidelines – GenZ Innovators Carnival Competition

## Poster Presentation Rules

### Eligibility

- Open to all UG and PG students from all Fields.
- Each team may have a maximum of 2 members
- Only one poster per team is permitted



### Poster Specifications

-  Poster Size: A1 (59.4 × 84.1 cm) or as specified by the organizers
-  Orientation: Portrait (preferred)
-  Posters must be neat, clear, and well-structured

### Poster Theme

- Poster must be based on the given theme or sub-theme
-  Content must be original

### Presentation Rules

-  5–6 minutes for poster explanation
-  2 minutes for question and answer session
-  Poster should be self-explanatory, visually appealing, and informative



# Rules & Guidelines – GenZ Innovators Carnival Competition Spot Web Design

## Eligibility

- Open to all UG and PG students from all Fields.
- Each team may have a maximum of 2 members
- Only one website per team is allowed

## Competition Format

-  Theme / problem statement will be provided on the spot
-  Duration: 2 Hours
- Teams must design a single-page or multi-page website based on the given theme

## Submission Rules

-  Website must be submitted as a ZIP file (as per instructions)
-  Late submissions will not be accepted
-  Submission must be done through the official submission form

## Tools & Technologies

### Allowed:

- HTML, CSS, JavaScript
- Bootstrap / Tailwind CSS
- AI tools (ChatGPT, Gemini, GitHub Copilot, etc.)

### Not Allowed:

- CMS platforms (WordPress, Wix, etc.)
- Direct copying of complete websites or templates

## System & Internet Usage

-  Teams must bring their own laptops (lab computers also available)
-  Internet access is allowed only for AI tools and development references
-  Misuse of the internet for copying ready-made websites will result in disqualification
