- 1. Word Limit for the paper: Research Paper: 2000 words
- 2. No. of Authors: Not more than three
- 3. Font Size a. For English: Times New Roman; Font Size: 12; Line Spacing: 1.5
 - b. For Devanagari (Marathi/Hindi) Google UNICODE; Font Size: 12; Line Spacing: 1.5
- 4. An empirical paper should include Abstract, Keywords, Introduction, Methodology, Result Description, Conclusion, Tables, Figures, and References. Theoretical and conceptual papers are also acceptable.
- 5. Author details: Full name, Designation, affiliating institute, Phone number, and email ID should be mentioned only on the first page of the manuscript.
- 6. Tables and charts should have self-explanatory titles and be numbered as referred to in the text. The sources, wherever necessary, should be mentioned at the bottom of the tables/charts/graphs.
- 7. Use APA7th Edition for in-text citation and referencing.
- 8. Plagiarism in any form is not accepted and if found, the paper shall be rejected and its presentation not allowed in the seminar.
